7. Follow up from Domestic Violence Conference: Highlights included
 - Kimmy Phan briefly discussed the Clothesline Project. During Domestic Violence Awareness Month, an exhibit of traditional dresses accompanying real stories from local domestic violence survivors from diverse ethnic communities will serve as a reminder that domestic violence is present and must be prevented. The “I Dare to Air—My Resilience, My Truth” Traveling Clothesline includes the Vietnamese Áo Dài, Cambodian Sampot Khmer, Chinese Qipao, Filipina Filipiniana, Indian Saree, Korean Hanbok, and Mexican Huipil Rojo, along with survivors’ stories of their struggles and triumphs in their own languages.
The exhibit will be displayed at the County of Santa Clara Government Center until the end of October, when it will travel to other destinations, including East Side Union High School District, family resource centers, and community spaces and agencies serving these neighborhoods.
 - Esther Peralez-Dieckmann, Executive Director of Next Door Solutions, expressed her vision at the conference.
 - Kim Walker spoke about Beverly Allen, author of Rape Warfare: The Hidden Genocide in Bosnia, and what an amazing speaker she was at the conference.
 - Amy Caffrey spoke about Domestic Violence in the LGBTQ community.
 - There was a discussion about Brigid McCaw’s presentation and the video she showed that was in Spanish, about a woman getting out of a relationship.
 - Panel from Kaiser integrated behavioral health/medical health. They talked about their model at Kaiser where they’re referring into behavioral health.
 - Maria Herenyiova really enjoyed the, “Gaslighting 21st Century Style tactics of the modern abuser” presentation in the afternoon, by Ruth Patrick.
