- WHEREAS, Bob Clement has dedicated his career to Biological Science as an educator serving the Santa Clara County Parks and Recreation Department, the Santa Clara County Juvenile Probation Department, the California Department of Food and Agriculture, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture;
- WHEREAS, Bob Clement has been extremely active in south Santa Clara County mobilizing a strong core of volunteers in service to the Friends of the Canada de los Osos Ecological Reserve as the board treasurer;
- WHEREAS, Bob Clement has volunteered for over 19 years to manage the Reserve under the California Department of Fish and Wildlife with the goals of youth outdoor education and natural resource enhancement;
- WHEREAS, Bob Clement has faithfully taught over 400 youth about responsible stewardship of the land and wildlife in the junior hunters program;
- WHEREAS, Bob Clement has faithfully ensured that over 1,200 youth experience the fun of fishing at larger stock ponds as part of the junior anglers program; and,
- WHEREAS, Bob Clement's influence has resulted in over 100 students participating in field courses at the Reserve in partnership with the San José State University Biology Department.

for working tirelessly to maintain the Reserve and provide community outreach, education, and research for the benefit of countless students and residents.
