It is vital that the Academic Growth Boundary should be extended for at least 99 years and the designated possible future school site relocated out of the foothills.

Preservation of the foothills is of tremendous importance to all residents of the mid-peninsula, both Stanford affiliates and those of us in the surrounding communities.
